The Child Education Society, the apex body of Bal Bharati Public Schools and other institutions of Higher Education, was set up in the year 1944 during the pre-independence era when the elders thought that Indian Culture, Heritage, Tradition and Ethos must be preserved and in order to achieve these objectives, it became obligatory for the Society to educate the young people. Thus, the Society was registered under the Societies Act, 1860.

The Society's educational philosophy is based on a progressive focused outlook that provides quality education rooted in the country's rich cultural background, offering opportunities for the development of different facets of a child's personality, particularly that of nobility of character.

Today the affairs of the Society are managed by the Board of Management consisting of eminent educationists and social workers. Sh L R Channa, an eminent Philanthropist is the President of the Society. Under his dynamic leadership the pace of expansion has greatly quickened in the recent years going up from just one school and one institution (NTTI)till 1984 to as many as 3 Institutes, 12 Core Schools 7 Project Schools in collaboration with the Railways and the NTPC and 2 Partnership Schools.

The Learning Environment

- Training in various art forms like sketching, painting, collage making and paper craft.

• Active, hands-on learning for students of the age group of 3+ to 16 years, including the Montessori system of education for pre-school (Mont.I) and Pre-primary (Mont-II) classes having rich activity-based, paedo-centric curriculum.

At present outdoor sports opportunities such as Tennis, Volley Ball, Badminton, Skating, Basket Ball etc. are offered to the pupils to choose from.

Our indoor sports and recreation comprise of Table Tennis, Yoga, Taekwondo, Carrom and Chess to name a few.

We also encourage our students to participate in Inter School Competitions. A standard size swimming pool alongwith a track for Athletics will be provided to the pupils in the coming sessions.

Faculty

The school boasts of well-qualified, trained and experienced faculty members who put to use innovative teaching-learning methodologies. The faculty members are selected after going through a stringent

selection process. Regular in-house workshops and seminars are conducted as capacity-enhancing exercises.

Curriculum

The English Medium Co-Educational Institute with classes upto Class XII, offering all three streams-Humanities, Pure Sciences and Commerce to its Students in Classes XI and XII is affiliated to the CBSE.

Transport

The school provides transport on selected routes. School buses are fitted with GPS tracking system and CCTV Cameras are run by experienced drivers and conductors. We take care to conform to the rules and regulations laid down by the Hon. Supreme Court of India and proper check-systems are in place in all the units.

Infirmary

The school's infirmary is equipped with first-aid facilities and a basic medical facility under a qualified Visiting Doctor. We take care of children not only in case of an illness but also follow a routine medical check-up of the students and staff.

Housekeeping Staff & Security

We have well-trained security staff to cater to the safety and security of children within the school premises. House keeping staff takes care of the cleaniliness and hygiene in the premises.

Fire safety

The school building is fitted with an inbuilt fire fighting system and has sufficient exit points for emergency evacuation.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ADMISSIONS OPEN FOR CLASSES MONT.I-CLASS XI

Age Eligibility

As on 31 March, of the current year the child should be

- 3-4Years for Mont-I
- 4-5Years for Mont-II and so on.

Documents Required with the Application Form

- a) Original and attested photocopy of Municipal Birth Certificate (child)
- b) Original and attested photocopy of Transfer Certificate of a Recognised School.
- c) Attested photocopy of proof of residence eg. Ration Card, Electricity bill, Passport, Voter ID, House Tax receipt. (any one in the name of child's parent)
- d) Photocopies of documents relating to both parents educational qualifications.
- e) Medical Fitness Certificate showing the blood group and outlining the immunisation shots given to the child.
- f) Two passport size Photographs
- g) Family Photographs

SCHOOL UNIFORM

(Style, design and fabric as specified)

It is compulsory for all students to wear prescribed school uniform. All items of summer and winter uniform, will be available with the uniform vendor on fixed dates in the school. Parents are advised to buy uniforms only from the approved fabricator in order to ensure correctness of material and tailoring, cut and style as well as price. A list of items of uniform with prices will be provided to the parents at the time of admission of their wards.

Transport Fees

Transport fee has been worked out depending on the distance. The charges can be obtained from the office or noted from the school notice board.

Transport charges (payable for 11 months) should be deposited along with the school fee, through a separate cheque.

Mode of Payment of Fees

- Fees is to be paid in four quarterly installments by the 20th of the first month of each quarter (i.e in April, July, October and January) by ECS. At the time of admission, fee is payable only by Bank Draft.
- 2. Annual Charges are payable in the first quarter only.

Find for Late Payment of Fee:

- Rs. 100/- for payment made after notified date till the 10th of the 2nd month of the quarter.
- Rs. 200/- for payment made between the 11th of the 2nd month till the 10th of the 3rd month of the quarter.
- Rs. 500/- for payment made after the 11th of the 3rd month till the last day of the quarter.

The name of the student will be struck off the rolls if fee is not paid by the end of the quarter and readmission fee will be charged.

Cheques returned by the bank for any reason will be treated as non-payment and fresh payment is to be made by Bank Draft, together with relevant fine as mentioned above plus Rs. 150/- for cheque being returned.
