The young man couldn't resist himself and went to the little girl to ask her how she was looking so calm and composed in the midst of the storm when everyone was terrified.

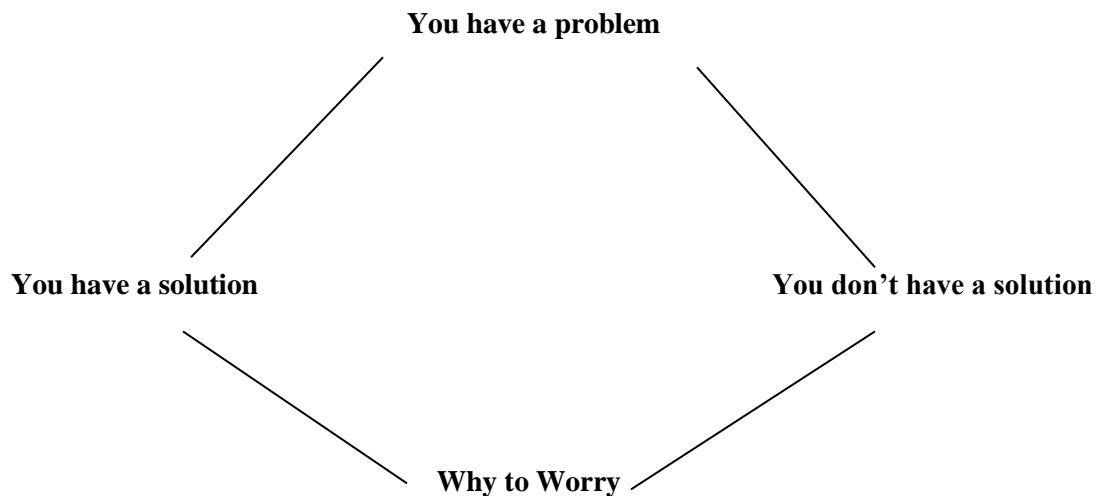
The girl replied with a pretty smile on her face 'My father was the pilot of this flight and I was confident that he will take me back safely to our home'
