
It gives me immense pleasure to welcome, Mr. L.R. Channa, President, Child Education Society, who has always been a source of inspiration for all of us.





English communication programme was organized by the English department of the school for all the students for a month in which they were made familiar with techniques personality development and refined their language skills.




TECHNO TRAINING PROGRAM

The school organized multiple "Techno Training Sessions" for staff members with the help of Computer department in order to enhance their knowledge of different softwares to be used in educational field.




PARENT'S FEEDBACK


A short documentary on the exploration of South Sky using the European space observatory was shown to the students of class 6th in which they explored different shapes of constellations in the night sky.






To bridge the gap and to upgrade the student's learning domain, various workshops and webinars have been attended by the students. To name a few:










PTA MEETING






- **❖** Infrared Thermometer is being used to check the temperature of every person entering the campus at the gate of the school.


