#### EXAM WEIGHTAGE IN DIFFERENT SITUATIONS(IX-XII)

- 1. STUDENTS ARE ABLE TO COME TO SCHOOLS: Obtained marks will be distributed equally between the two terms
- 2. TERM I IS ONLINE & TERM II IS OFFLINE: Weightage of Online exams will be reduced and weightage of Term II exams will be increased in final result
- 3. TERM I IS OFFLINE & TERM II IS ONLINE :Weightage of Online exams will be reduced and weightage of Term I exams will be increased in final result
- 4. TERM I&II ARE ONLINE: Result will be computed on the basis of Internal Assessment/Practical/Project work and Theory marks of Term I&II taken by the candidates online.

#### **NOTE OF IMPORTANCE:**

1.Letter grades on eight-point scale shall be used for subjects of scholastic examinations.

2.In order to be declared as 'passed' a candidate shall obtain not less than 33% marks in each of the five subjects separately and in aggregate.

3.Student has to secure 33 % marks out of overall 20 marks earmarked in each subject in Internal Assessment too.

4.A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of scholastic examination shall be placed in compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment.

5. In case of absence due to medical reason, the student may be exempted from Half Yearly Examination in the respective subject and may be promoted on the basis of the Annual Examination only. However if a student fails to appear for Annual Examination due to Medical grounds, he/she shall give his/her exam along with compartment examination. Medical certificate is necessary.

6.A student having less than 75% attendance in an academic session shall not be permitted to appear in the final Examination.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (Periodic Assessment, Portfolio, Multiple Assessment, Sub Enrichment)

1. The evaluation for subjects of internal assessment shall be based on cumulative record of his/her continuous assessment in the school.

2. Schools are expected to maintain regular records of student's achievement and progress.

# COSCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT:(I-VIII)

For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out in our school by the teachers and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:

# ELIGIBILITY FOR COMPARTMENT EXAM

- 1. A candidate failing in more than one of the five subjects of scholastic examination shall be declared as failed.
- 2. A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of scholastic examination for classes I -XII shall be placed in compartment in those subjects provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment.
- 3. Any other promotion rule applicable as per the policy of Directorate of Education, Haryana CBSE.
- 4. Student will be awarded Marks as well as grades in classes I-X.
- 5. It is mandatory to appear in all Examinations.
