

A TRIP TO THE ARAVALLIS

22nd of April is observed as 'Earth Day' throughout the world with the motto of saving the environment. To mark the importance of the day, Bal Bharati Public School, Manesar, took the initiative for the young learners to organise a trip to The Aravallis, which is one of the oldest mountain ranges in the world and is considered to be the green lungs of the environment. The main motive of the visit was not only to adopt a small area in the vicinity of Aravalli hills but also to maintain the bio diversity of that area in future. The theme of Earth Day 2022 was "Invest in Our Planet". A team of 35 students and 6 teachers visited the hills in the evening of 22nd April,2022. Under the robust leadership of Mr. K.K. Yadav, an active environmentalist and a retired director of town and country planning HSIIDC. students were briefed how the Japanese method has been implemented to plant saplings and grow trees to save the Mother Earth.
