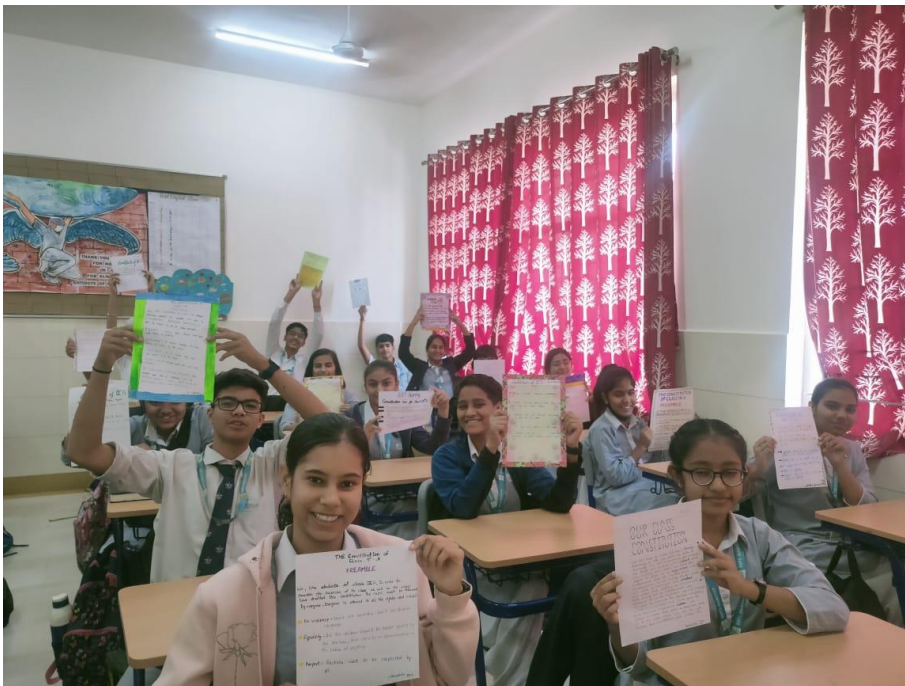
**Description** - An activity was conducted in Class IX A on 'Designing a Classroom Constitution'.

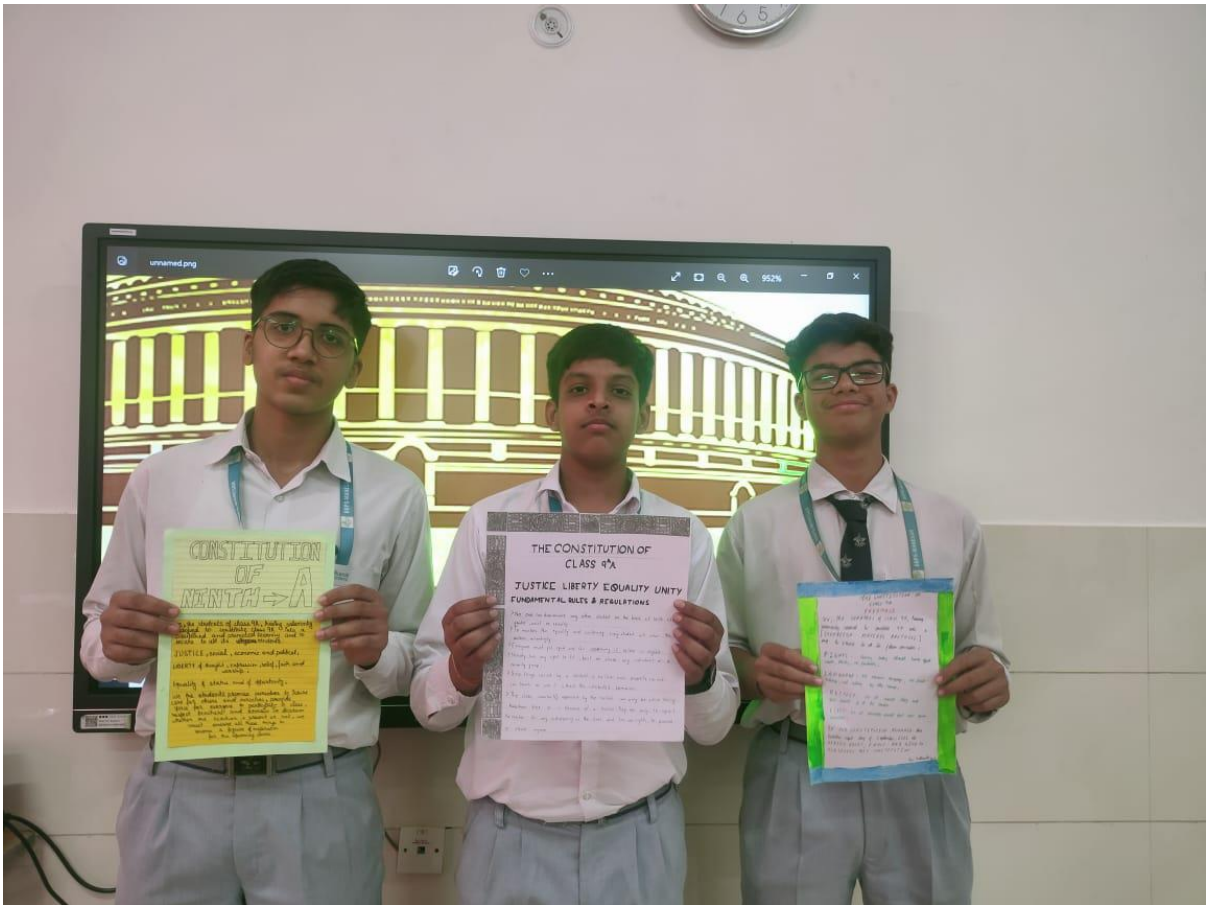
The objective is to make students understand the importance of having rules to maintain order at home, at school, in their community, and their country.
