ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS

It is mandatory for a student to pass in the additional subject in class IX as per passing criteria. For students who are unable to meet the passing criteria, a retest will be scheduled.

PROMOTION POLICY AND CUMULATIVE RESULT

- 1. In order to be declared as having passed the class IX examination, the student must have obtained
- 2. 33 marks in the aggregate and 33% in each subject.
- 3. In the scholastic area, a student needs to secure overall 33% marks (both Pen Paper Test & Internal Assessment taken together) (i.e D Grade) to be able to pass that subject.
- 4. A student scoring less than 33% (i.e E grade) in more than 2 subjects will be detained. Retest is permitted in maximum of 2 subjects only.
- 5. If a student studies three compulsory subjects (i.e., Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and also chooses to study a Skill subject (offered as sixth optional subject), then the aggregate of best five including two languages (Subject 1 & 2) and the best three (from subject 3, 4, 5 & 6, including Skill subject) can be considered for calculation of percentage.

Re-Examination/ Compartment (Class-IX)

• A student scoring less than 33% (i.e E grade) in 2 subjects will be permitted Retest in those subjects. The retest will be conducted in Term 2 only.

Missed Test / Exams

- A) If one of the UT is missed, then the HALF YEALY &other UT will be counted for the assessment.
- B) If more than one UT are missed, then proportionate marks are to be allotted.

Assessment of co-scholastic areas

Assessment of Co-scholastic areas will be done as per the **CBSE guidelines.**
