Friendship Day is round the corner, the students were given A Writing skill bases activity- to create a comic strip/ poem on friendship and they presented it in a fun and creative way .

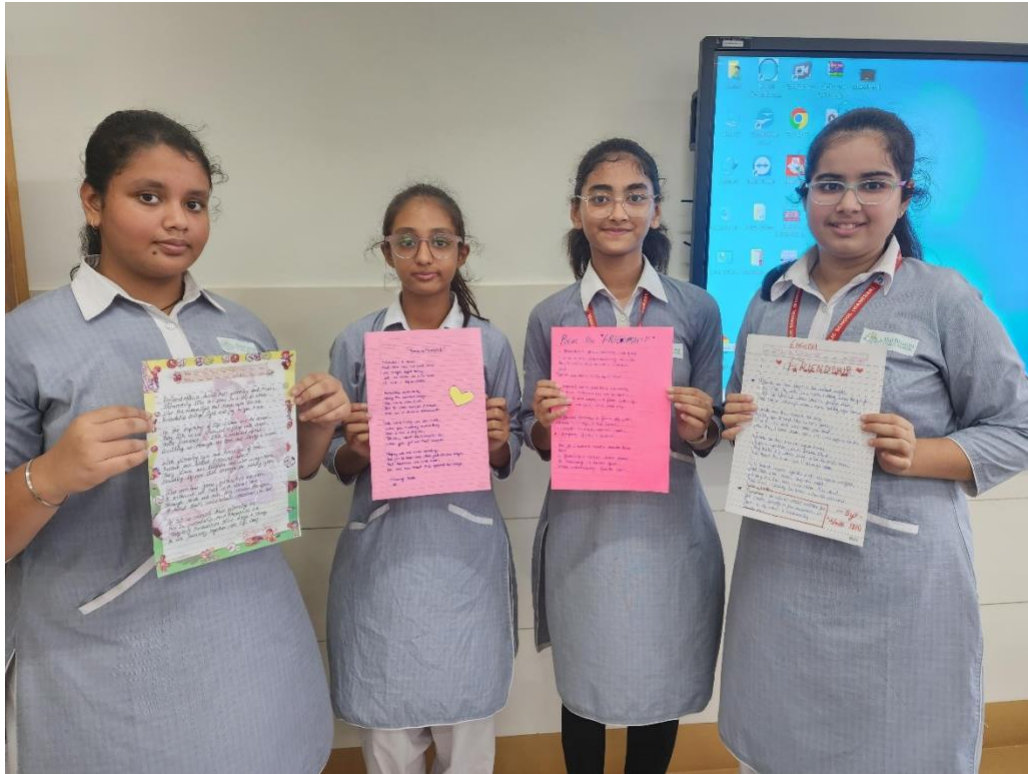
For the comic strip they explored the theme of friendship and its various aspects. The comic strip activity involved creating a series of comic panels that depict different scenarios and situations related to friendship.
