to put double efforts the next time, so as to create a more impactful campaign.



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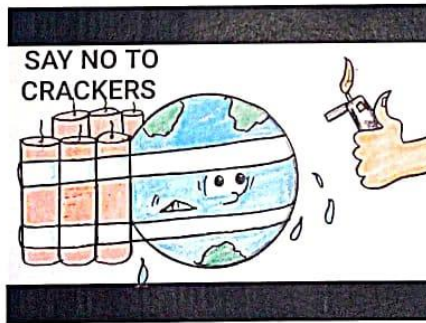

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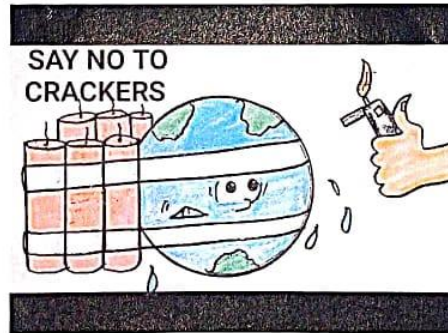
