### PROMOTION POLICY

- ATTENDANCE CRITERIA:
  - Every student must have a **minimum of 75%** attendance to be eligible for final examination.
- ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE:
  - UT1 – May
  - Half Yearly Exams – September
  - UT2 – December
  - Annual Exams – February
- EXAM WEIGHTAGE:
  - **20%** (UT1, UT2) – 25 marks
  - **20%** (Half Yearly) – as per the CBSE pattern
  - **60%** (Annual Exams) – as per the CBSE pattern
- PROMOTION CRITERIA:
  - A minimum of **33%** marks in Theory as well as **33%** in Practical (INDIVIDUALLY for EACH SUBJECT)
  - Additionally, a **minimum of 33% score in Annual Exam** for each subject.
- RETEST POLICY:
  - A student **obtaining less than 33% in more than one subject does not qualify for retest and shall be detained.** RETEST IS PERMITTED ONLY IN ONE SUBJECT.
  - Furthermore, it should be noted that a **retest will ONLY be conducted** if a student is out ON DUTY or has missed the Exam due to a GENUINE MEDICAL REASON.
- ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS:
  - It is mandatory for a **student to pass in the additional subject in class XI** as per passing criteria discussed. Students not fulfilling this requirement will be asked to drop the additional subject in class XII.
- USE OF UNFAIR MEANS
  - During the Examination, if a student is found indulging in any kind of unfair practice, the Exam will stand cancelled, and the child will be awarded zero marks (applicable to Unit Test Exams and Half Yearly Exams).
  - In the Annual Exam, he/she will have to appear for a retest in the Subject.

➤ GRADING SCALE FOR SCHOLASTIC AREAS:

- School will award grades as per the following grading scale:
