23rd May:- Assemble in school by 5.00 A.M to depart by 5.30 A.M to Ranthambore with packed refreshment. Arrival at Ranthambore by 1.00 P.M. Check in & Rest. After lunch we leave for **Ranthambore Museum & Village trek**.

In the evening a **documentary on wildlife** will be played followed by **Rajasthani cultural program** at the hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

24th May:- Wake up early in the morning to leave for **Ranthambore Wildlife Sanctuary** in Canter stopping from time to time to have a close glimpse of the wildlife. Back to hotel. Breakfast and rest till lunch. After lunch visit to **Ranthambore Fort**. In the evening dance at the **'Beats of Music'**. Dinner & overnight at hotel.

25th May:- After breakfast depart for Delhi. Arrival at school by 2.30P.M.

Cost: - Rs 9100/- Per Student

Cost includes:-Hotel Accommodation on Sharing basis, all meals, Transportation by Coach, Additional program fees, Wildlife safari, Monument and guide fees, GST.

Cost does not include any other item referred above.

Instructions:-

1. Parents should drop and pick up their wards at the specified time.
2. Proper discipline should be maintained throughout the trip.
3. No littering around in the bus and at the hotel.
4. Valuables & electronic gadgets such as mobile phones and cameras are strictly prohibited.
5. No plastic pouches/bottles/containers are permitted through an Act of the Govt. Therefore, no student should be in possession of any type of plastic items.
6. Children should not throw wrappers or any other waste outside the bus en route.
7. Students should travel light since they have to carry their own baggage to their respective rooms.
