Examples:

Reflections in water.

Architecture with mirrored elements, like doors or windows.

Symmetrical faces or bodies in portrait photography

Patterns involve the repetition of shapes, lines, colors, or textures in a photo.

Types of Patterns:

Natural Patterns: Found in nature, like the arrangement of leaves, the scales on a fish, or the ridges in sand dunes.

Man-made Patterns: Created by human-made objects, like the tiles on a floor, the bricks in a wall, or the seats in a theater.


