Leading lines are a powerful compositional technique in photography that use lines within the frame to guide the viewer's eye towards a specific point of interest or to create a sense of depth and perspective.

## **Types of Leading Lines:**

**Natural Lines:** These can include elements like rivers, roads, fences, or tree branches that occur naturally in the environment.

**Architectural Lines:** Man-made structures such as staircases, bridges, railings, or building facades can provide strong lines that lead the viewer's eye.


