## REPORT ON POCSO WORKSHOP

On 7th December 2024, an important workshop on the *Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO)* Act was conducted at BBPS Manesar by Dr. Richa Aggarwal. The workshop was specifically designed for the support and administrative staff of the school, aiming to raise awareness about child protection, the significance of the POCSO Act, and its application in everyday interactions with children both in and outside the school premises.

The primary objectives of the workshop were:

- 1. To educate staff about the POCSO Act and its importance.

She explained that the Act was enacted to address the sexual abuse and exploitation of children and that it provides a robust framework for the protection of children across India.

The workshop detailed the different types of abuse that children may face, focusing not only on physical or sexual abuse but also emotional and psychological abuse. Dr. Aggarwal emphasized the importance of recognizing subtle signs of distress or harm in children, which might not always be visible in an overt manner.

Dr. Aggarwal discussed best practices for creating a safe school environment. She highlighted the importance of maintaining safe boundaries with students, fostering open lines of communication with children, and ensuring proper supervision of children in school and extracurricular activities
