





Participation in Extracurricular Activities – Involves drills, social service projects, and outdoor training. 4.Enhances Career Opportunities – Can be beneficial for students applying to higher education and jobs where NCC certificates are considered 5. There will be three camps in a year in the school. Duration of one camp will be three days, during school timings only.
